Wednesday notes – what are these?

The CCS Wednesday note is Coeur d'Alene Christian School's primary way of communicating with you, our students' parents. These are sent home every Wednesday. Please read all the information in the envelope each week. Sign the outside of the envelope by the appropriate date and return to CCS with your child the next day.

Hot lunches

We will be offering hot lunches every day! Mr. & Mrs. Weller, our catering couple, will provide our Tuesday hot lunch. They offer us specific menu items (i.e., spaghetti; chilidogs) and generally cook the same item two weeks consecutively. Our Friday hot lunches will be purchased and served by CCS staff (or parent volunteers) and will alternate between Pizza Hut and Wendy's, or occasionally be prepared by the "K.I.D.S. Club"(PTO). Mrs. Welter, one of our school moms, will cook the hot lunch meals on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Order forms for hot lunches will be sent home in the Wednesday note. Please fill these in and return with your payment the next day. Lunches cost \$2.50 each.

Milk Program

We will have milk cartons available for purchase during the school year. Milk cards may be purchased at the office for \$5.00 per card (a card is good for 10 milk cartons @ \$.50 per carton) or may be purchased on a per carton basis (\$.50 per carton). Teachers will keep their students' purchased milk cards in their classrooms and will inform parents when cards are used up. Chocolate and white milk are the choices available to the students.

Tuition Payments

Coeur d'Alene Christian School's annual tuition is divided into 10 equal payments. These are due on the first of each month from September through June. *A late fee of \$10.00 will be charged for payments that are received after the 10th of each month.* (June's payment must be paid by June 1st as school is out just a few days later.) Payment can be mailed to CCS or brought in to the office.
